

Whats the deal with TRASH?

Bulky Trash

Each week with your regular trash/recycling pickup, you can also include up to a combined 4 cubic yards of bulky trash / bundled brush.

Anything over 4 cubic yards will automatically generate a fee. That fee will be added to your future water bill.

- Under 4 cubic yards = FREE
- Over 4 cubic yards = \$25.00/per 4 yard dump + 12 yards = \$125.00/hour + \$25.00/per ton

Trash Carts

Progressive Waste Solutions provide residents with 1 trash cart and 1 recycle cart.

Additional carts are available for a nominal monthly fee. To order please contact Murphy Customer Service.

* non Progressive Waste trash carts are not allowed for curbside pickup.

Landfill Drop Off

City of Murphy residents may dispose of up to 5 cubic yards or 2,000 lbs of household bulky trash / brush with a current utility bill or valid Murphy address driver's license once per month. Loads must be covered with a tarp.

Frequently Asked Questions

Q: Progressive picks up 4 cubic yards of bulky trash a week, how do I know how much that is?

A: It's about the size of a standard dishwasher.

Q: What is bundled brush and why do I have to do that?

A: Limbs/branches that have been cut into 4 foot lengths with twine/rope/string around the bundles. Please note, bundles may not exceed 50 lbs each. Bundled brush is not only easier/faster for the trash workers to put in the truck, but it also ensures all brush will be collected.

Q: How do I know when my trash day is?

A: Monday: Murphy Farms, Skyline Acres, and The Timbers

Tuesday: Maxwell Creek

Wednesday: The Ranch

Thursday: Daniel Crossing, Glen Ridge Estates, Hunters Landing, Stratford Crossing.

Friday: Rolling Ridge, The Aviary, Windyhill Farms

Saturday: No regular pickup. Saturday pickup only when affected by a holiday.



If you have a natural Christmas Tree or wreath for disposal, Progressive Waste will happily pick them up on your normal trash day.

Be sure to:

- remove all decorations and lights
- wrap flocked trees in plastic
