Issue

Joint discussion with City of Richardson City Council regarding a proposed Multi Agency Recreation Center to be built in Breckenridge Park.

Background

On October 18, 2011, representatives from the City of Richardson; Ballard and King and Associates; and Barker Rinker Seacat; presented information to City Council regarding a proposed joint project for a Multi-Agency Recreation Center to be built in Breckenridge Park in the City limits of Richardson.

On November 1, 2011, City Council authorized the City Manager to enter into an interlocal agreement with the City of Richardson for Phase 1 of a feasibility study not to exceed \$15,000.

Phase 1 of the study was to consist of Market Analysis and Programming and Operation/Revenue Projections.

The January 17th Joint Meeting will be an opportunity for City Council to discuss the proposed project with the Richardson City Council. A joint public meeting will also be scheduled for January 26th at Miller Elementary in Richardson.
