

TEMPORARY SIGNS

On Tuesday, 9/15/2020 the City of Murphy City Council amended the Emergency Declaration for Covid-19 to allow new regulations regarding special purpose signs.

The revised sign regulations will go into effect Tuesday, September 15, 2020, and will remain in effect concurrent with the City's Covid-19 Emergency Declaration.

The following rules for special purpose signs are as follows:

- Temporary special purpose signs include: banners, feather flags *not to exceed 15 feet in height*.
- All signs shall be located on private property, and may not obstruct visibility along roadways, at intersections or in parking lots.
- A maximum of four (4) special purpose signs shall be allowed per business.
- Temporary signs shall not exceed four (4) square feet in area or three (3) feet in height.
- Heavier than air inflatables are not part of this program. Inflatables shall follow the standard requirements of the Murphy Sign Ordinance.
- Signs mounted on skids, trailers or wheels, and signs with moving parts are prohibited.
- All signs shall be located on private property. Do not place signs within the public right-of-way (the area between the public sidewalk and street curb).
- These regulations are for any commercial business with a physical store location in Murphy.
