Wal-Mart's grand opening was a festive affair on July 17. The store's address is **115 W. FM 544**, just west of the intersection of **North Murphy Road**. Speeches, acknowledgements, music, ribbon-cutting, and check presentations were all part of the well-attended festivities.

Mayor Pro Tem Owais Siddiqui represented the City of Murphy and thanked the retailer for coming to town, bringing what amounts to about 250 full-time jobs to the area, along with, of course, a healthy sales tax revenue stream. Several Council members were present as well, demonstrating their support of the retailer.

Dirt is moving for the **iShine Car Wash**. It'll be located directly in front of Orchard Park, next to a soon-to-be constructed **Braum's**. The **Emerus Hospital**, on the western edge of the city, is also being constructed and now has walls and a solid exterior. It should be completed by February of next year.



Murphy PSA is already planning to have their first tournament by November with a planned opening date in October. The City expects PSA to become a cornerstone of the community that will bring in a great amount of traffic from outside the city as well as generating increased marketability and new tax dollars to Murphy.
